ARCHIE SOLO PRIVACY POLICY

THIS PRIVACY POLICY EXPLAINS HOW P-1 AI, INC. ("P-1 AI," "WE," "US," OR "OUR") COLLECTS, USES, AND DISCLOSES INFORMATION WHEN YOU USE ARCHIE SOLO AND RELATED WEBSITES, APPLICATIONS, AND SERVICES (COLLECTIVELY, THE "SERVICE").

1. Information We Collect. We may collect the following categories of information:
 - Account information, such as your name, email address, employer, and login information.
 - Input and Output, including prompts, files, data, materials, and other content you submit to the Service, and content generated in response.
 - Usage and device information, such as your IP address, browser and device type, operating system, access times, pages or features used, referring URLs, and diagnostic and performance information.
 - Communications, including information you provide when contacting us for support or otherwise communicating with us.
 - Cookies and similar technologies used to operate the Service, maintain sessions, understand usage, and improve performance.

Please do not submit personal information or other sensitive, regulated, confidential, or commercially valuable information through Input unless P-1 AI has expressly agreed in writing to process it.

2. How We Use Information. We may use information to:
 - provide, operate, maintain, secure, and support the Service;
 - authenticate users and administer accounts;
 - process Input and generate Output;
 - monitor performance, prevent fraud and abuse, and protect the security of the Service;
 - communicate with you about the Service;
 - comply with law and enforce our agreements; and
 - develop, train, evaluate, and improve the Service and related artificial-intelligence models.

As described in the Archie Solo Terms of Use, P-1 AI may perpetually retain, reproduce, and use Input and Output for its internal purposes of training and improving the Service and may provide Input and Output to its agents and subprocessors for those purposes. P-1 AI is not required to delete Input or Output.

3. How We Disclose Information. We may disclose information:

- to vendors, agents, subprocessors, cloud-service providers, model providers, analytics providers, and other service providers that help us operate, secure, support, train, and improve the Service;
- to professional advisers, such as lawyers, auditors, and insurers;
- when reasonably necessary to comply with law, legal process, or governmental requests;
- when reasonably necessary to protect P-1 AI, our users, the public, or the Service;
- in connection with a financing, merger, acquisition, reorganization, sale of assets, or similar transaction; and
- with your direction or consent.

We do not sell personal information for monetary consideration or use personal information for cross-context behavioral advertising. Third-party providers may collect information through the Service over time. We do not permit third parties to use the Service to track users across unaffiliated websites for targeted advertising.

4. Retention. We retain account, usage, communications, and other information for as long as reasonably necessary for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy, including operating and securing the Service, complying with legal obligations, resolving disputes, and enforcing agreements. Input and Output may be retained perpetually for training and improvement purposes.

5. Your Choices. You may request access to or correction of your account information, or request termination of your account, by contacting **support-solo@p-1.ai**. You may control cookies through your browser settings. Disabling cookies may prevent some parts of the Service from functioning properly.

Because there is no generally accepted standard for responding to browser-based “Do Not Track” signals, the Service does not currently respond to those signals. Nevada residents may submit a verified request directing us not to make a covered sale of covered information by contacting **legal@p-1.ai**. We do not currently engage in such sales.

6. Security. We use reasonable administrative, technical, and organizational measures designed to protect information. No system or method of transmission is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

7. Children. The Service is not directed to children under 13, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13. If you believe a child has provided personal information to us, contact **legal@p-1.ai**.

8. International Users. P-1 AI is based in the United States. If you access the Service from outside the United States, your information may be transferred to, stored in, and processed in the United States and other countries where P-1 AI or its service providers operate. However, the Service is intended solely for users located in the United States

and is not offered or made available to persons located in the European Economic Area, the United Kingdom, or Switzerland. Please do not access or use the Service from those jurisdictions. If we learn that information has been submitted through the Service by a person located in one of those jurisdictions, we may restrict or terminate access and take such other steps as we consider appropriate, subject to applicable law.
